SUBSCRIPTION FEES

Bowling Member Subscription

Full year January to December for lawn and short-mat bowls, snooker, all club facilities and activities: £83.00

Intermediate Bowling Member Subscription

Concession for Bowling Members age 18 to 25: £25.00

Junior Bowling Member Subscription

17 and under. Must be under adult supervision in the clubhouse and club matches: £18.00

Snooker Member Subscription

Snooker membership allows access to the clubhouse, playing of snooker and all social events: £44.00

Social Member Subscription

Allows access to clubhouse, short-mat bowls and games (not snooker) and social events: £18.00

NEW MEMBER JOINING FEE

Administration fee payable by new members on first joining the club: £10.00

INTRODUCTION TO THE CLUB

For established bowlers

If you have bowled before and wish to join the club, you will be asked to join one of our coaches for a few trial ends. On successful completion your application will be cleared, and you will be given full access to the Green.

For new bowlers

On successful completion of your four-week induction course you will be linked with a mentor (a bowling buddy), who will provide you with guidance and encouragement during your early weeks with us. Our intention is to make you feel welcome and to get you involved in the LBC community.

For snooker players

To play snooker at the club, you must have a briefing with the club snooker captain, and an induction to the facility. You may then be authorised to use the snooker tables and equipment, and invited to join the snooker section, if you are not already a bowling member.

All new members

All new members provided with a full introduction to the club. You will be invited to join in a discussion with some of the club's senior members, who will highlight how you can get involved in all aspects of the club such as galas, friendly and competitive matches and social events.
